

HEALTH AND EMERGENCY INFORMATION

1. All medication (prescription and over the counter) to be taken during the school day is to be kept in the nurse's office.

A medication form for the 2016-2017 school year is on our website to be used for prescription and over the counter orders.

If your child requires emergency medication such as an EpiPen we should have this medication in the nurse's office at all times with an emergency medication form completed by the physician. **These are available online.**

2. Physical exams are required for all new students and those entering preschool and kindergarten. It is recommended that all students have annual physicals. Any child playing a sport during the year will need a current physical that was completed within 365 days of the start of that particular sport. Forms are available online at www.assumptionnj.org to be completed by the physician.
3. If your child is diagnosed with a contagious disease during the school year, such as strep throat, "pink eye", or head lice, please notify the nurse's office. A student diagnosed with "pink eye" requires a physician's note to return to school.
4. If your child suffers an injury or illness which prevents him or her from participating in physical education class, a physician's note is required to excuse your child from class.
