Morristown Grapplers: Matt Niemczyk, Assumption Dad, is involved with the Morristown Grapplers - the town recreation wrestling program. Below is a brief overview of the Morristown Grapplers programs this winter. The season starts November 14th. If anyone has questions, feel free to email Matt at mniemczyk1@gmail.com

Pre-Clinic: K-2nd grade: This program is designed for the beginner wrestler in K–2nd grade. Coaches developed a program that uses a games-based approach to teach the sport of wrestling in a fun, engaging, safe way that keeps everyone on the mat and moving.

Clinic: 3rd – 5th grade (some 1st & 2nd graders will be considered): This program is designed for first and second year wrestlers in 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders. Our coaches developed our Clinic program with a strong focus on basic wrestling techniques and the goal of providing a strong foundation for the sport of wrestling.

Junior Varsity & Varsity: 3rd – 8th grade: This program is designed for all wrestlers in 6th – 8th grades, and wrestlers in 3rd – 5th with 2 full years of competition under their belt. Structured practice, focus on drilling with a partner. Wrestlers compete on a team in one of two leagues, Future Stars Wrestling League for JV and Tri-County Wrestling League for Varsity.

A NOTE FROM THE NURSE'S OFFICE:

Basketball Medical Clearance Forms Due: Any student wishing to play Assumption basketball must have a current Preparticipation Physical Exam Form on file with the school nurse **BEFORE** the season begins. These forms are only valid for 365 days from the date of the exam. If your child's most recent physical exam is over 90 days old, you are also required to submit the 90 day Health Update form. School Policy Reminder: Children must be free of vomit, diarrhea and fever (without fever reducing medication) **for a full 24 hours before returning to school.**

To all PreK3 and PreK4 parents: All Preschool students are required to receive their annual flu vaccine before Christmas break. Please submit a copy of your child's immunization record to the school nurses as soon as possible.

To Parents of 6th Graders: All 6th grade students are required to receive the Meningitis/TDap vaccinations. An updated copy of your child's immunization record was due **by Friday, October 14th**. If you have not yet submitted your child's immunization record, please do so today. If they have not yet received these vaccines, please email the school nurses with the date of the upcoming appointment.
